Thursday 30th November

Keynote Speakers

Prof. dr. André Vyt is an expert in the field of interprofessional education and published various articles and books on this topic. He is behavioral and educational scientist, works as a Quality assurance expert in the domains of health care and education, and is the Chair of the European Interprofessional Practice & Education Network (EIPEN) since 2011. He authored interprofessional tools such as the shared care matrix and the IPEQS assessment tool. He is also lecturer at Ghent University and Artevelde University College. His keynote lecture focuses on using the 5 Keys model for interprofessional competences in higher education, specialized training courses, and continuous professional development.





Willem Philipsen will give a lecture about finding meaning and creating new opportunities. How do you find the strength to keep going when everything seems to be going against you? He will take you on a journey and inspire you by the story of someone who completely reinvented himself after suffering from a stroke. His immense humour, perseverance, and love for life have brought him to where he is now.
