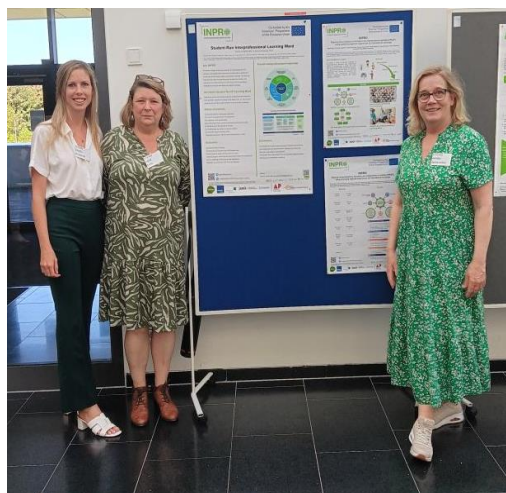


Harvesting season - Time to share the results of the INPRO Project!
