



ZORO-Training: Module Interprofessioneel Samenwerken

Description

ZORO is a project in which 5 partners jointly develop a training to strengthen (future) healthcare professionals in four competences: interprofessional collaboration, technological agility, intrapreneurship and ethical behaviour.

Participants of level 1-6 * (students, starting professionals (0-5 years' experience), experienced professionals (more than 10 years' experience)) follow the ZORO-training in mixed groups. The ZORO-training consist of 4 modules, of which the module interprofessional collaboration is the first one. The aim is to strengthen the competence of the participants through the training and validate the ZORO-training.

Cooperation partner: Partner universities and the governor of a province. Participants from hospitals, residential care centres, home care institutions, the disabled sector, colleges, secondary schools, adult education are welcome to join the ZORO training.
