In the pilot we also had ICF training but it was based on the ICF basic course developed during this INPRO project. Coronaria is developing further ICF training, see ICF training to all rehabilitation professionals. This material includes the modified RPS form (only in Finnish) and the very basic subsets for speech therapists working with children and adults. The subsets are developed by speech therapists at Coronaria. The subsets will be further developed in the future along with our ICF training.
